1.0 Regularly Scheduled Prison Board Meeting Called to Order by Commissioner Scott Metzger.

- 1.1 Meeting convened at 8:30 A.M.
- 1.2 Approval of Minutes: Mark Mussina motioned for approval of January 2026 meeting Minutes. Thomas Marino seconded the motion; the motion carried.
- 1.3 Public Comment (Agenda Items Only) – None

2.0 Expenditure Report:

- 2.1 Approval of Expenditure Report: Mark Mussina motioned for the approval of January 2026 Expenditure Report. Thomas Marino seconded the motion; the motion was carried.

3.0 Personnel Actions:

3.1 Mark Mussina made a motion to accept personnel actions; seconded by Thomas Marino; the motion was carried.

4.0 Informational Reports/Highlights: Warden Shoemaker reviewed the January Prison Reports as follows:

4.1 Population:

- Males in blocks averaged 202.87; males in PRC averaged 38.71; the total average daily population of males equaled 241.58, with a peak of 247.00.
- Females in blocks averaged 28.61; females in PRC averaged 8.81, the total average daily population of females equaled 37.42, with a peak of 43.00.
- The combined average daily population of male/female population equaled 279.00, with a peak of 289.00.
- In-Home detention averaged 0.00 males and 0.00 females.
- With no overcrowding transfer population, the total average daily population was equal to the monthly average daily population of 279.00.

4.2 Prison Disciplinary Hearings conducted and chaired by Deputy Warden of Inmate Services Barnes:

- Of 48 hearings conducted for 24 inmates, 7 inmates had more than one incident. 44 hearings resulted in guilty lock-ups; 4 hearing resulted in guilty lock-up with time suspended; 0 inmates were found not guilty; and, staff generated 21 informational reports.

4.3 Pre-Release

Work Release males equaled 8 and females equaled 5.

- Work crew males equaled 30 and work crew females equaled 4.
- The monthly average for males at the Pre-Release Center equaled 38 and females equaled 9. The year-to-date average equaled 38 males and 9 females.

4.4 Mental Health Snapshot taken on February 10, 2026:

- Of 310 total inmates in the prison system, 268 males and 42 females were categorized as follows.
- 108 males and 4 females made up Roster A, those who had no mental health history, which equated to 36.13% of the population.
- 59 males and 13 females made up Roster B, those who had past mental health history but no active symptoms in the last year, which equated to 23.22% of the population.
- 90 males and 20 females made up Roster C, those who had current mental health issues, which equated to 35.49% of the population.
- 11 males and 5 females made up Roster D, those who were determined to have serious mental illness, which equated to 5.16% of the population.

4.5 Psychotropic Medication at PRC:

- Of 34 male Work Crew inmates, 9 were on psychotropic medications. Of 11 male Work Release inmates, 2 were on psychotropic medications. Total medicated males at PRC equaled 18.18%.
- Of 7 female Work Crew inmates, 5 were on psychotropic medications. Of 5 females Work Release, 4 was on psychotropic medications. Total medicated females at PRC equaled 75.00%.
- Psychotropic Medication at LCP: Of 208 males overall, 94 (45.19%) were on psychotropic medications. Of 28 females overall, 15 (53.57%) were on psychotropic medications.

- Total Medicated Inmates within the Prison System: Overall, PRC averaged 35.09% medicated inmates. LCP averaged 46.19% medicated inmates. The total average percentage equaled 44.03% medicated inmates in the prison system.

4.6 Informational Highlights

- On January 20, 2026, Nurse Supervisor Erin Dvorscak, Deputy Warden Barnes and Warden Shoemaker met with representatives from River Valley Health and West Branch Drug and Alcohol Abuse Commission to discuss the prison's MAT program.
- On January 27, 2026, Deputy Warden Barnes and PRC Manager Thompson attended an employment expo at the PA College of Technology.
- On January 29, 2026, prison staff participated in contraband and cell search training conducted by Training Sgt. Billie Mitcheltree.

- 6.1 Discussion regarding the Commissioners approved a Memorandum of Understanding between the Court of Common Pleas, specifically the Adult Probation Office and the Prison to assist with inmate transportation for medical appointments or medical procedures and supervision of inmates who may be admitted to the hospital. The Prison has worked closely with Adult Probation received and received support from President Judge Linhardt for this ad we are greatly appreciative the efforts that were made by the Common Pleas Court.


