**1.0 Regularly Scheduled Prison Board Meeting Called to Order by Commissioner Scott Metzger.**

- 1.1 Meeting convened at 8:31 A.M.
- 1.2 Approval of Minutes: Mark Musina motioned for approval of March 2026 meeting minutes. Thomas Marino seconded the motion; the motion carried.
- 1.3 Public Comment (Agenda Items Only) – None

**2.0 Expenditure Report:**

- 2.1 Approval of Expenditure Report: Nicki Gottschall motioned for the approval of March 2026 Expenditure Report. Thomas Marino seconded the motion; the motion was carried.

### 3.0 **Personnel Actions:**

3.1 Thomas Marino made a motion to accept new hires; seconded by Nicki Gottschall; the motion was carried.

### 4.0 **Informational Reports/Highlights:** Warden Shoemaker reviewed the Mark Prison Reports as follows:

#### 4.1 Population:

- Males in blocks averaged 205.90; males in PRC averaged 44.84; the total average daily population of males equaled 250.74, with a peak of 258.00.
- Females in blocks averaged 29.81; females in PRC averaged 15.68, the total average daily population of females equaled 45.48, with a peak of 51.00.
- The combined average daily population of male/female population equaled 296.23, with a peak of 305.00.
- In-Home detention averaged 0.39 males and 0.00 females.
- With no overcrowding transfer population, the total average daily population was equal to the monthly average daily population of 296.23.

#### 4.2 Prison Disciplinary Hearings conducted and chaired by Deputy Warden of Inmate Services Barnes:

- Of 63 hearings conducted for 36 inmates, 9 inmates had more than one incident. 61 hearings resulted in guilty lock-ups; 1 hearing resulted in guilty lock-up with time suspended; 1 inmate was found not guilty; and, staff generated 7 informational reports.

#### 4.3 Pre-Release

Work Release males equaled 9 and females equaled 4.

- Work crew males equaled 36 and work crew females equaled 12.
- The monthly average for males at the Pre-Release Center equaled 45 and females equaled 16. The year-to-date average equaled 43 males and 13 females.

#### 4.4 Mental Health Snapshot taken on April 7, 2026:

- Of 320 total inmates in the prison system, 275 males and 45 females were categorized as follows.
- 112 males and 7 females made up Roster A, those who had no mental health history, which equated to 37.19 of the population.
- 54 males and 13 females made up Roster B, those who had past mental health history but no active symptoms in the last year, which equated to 20.94% of the population.
- 98 males and 19 females made up Roster C, those who had current mental health issues, which equated to 36.56% of the population.
- 11 males and 6 females made up Roster D, those who were determined to have serious mental illness, which equated to 5.31% of the population.

#### 4.5 Psychotropic Medication at PRC:

- Of 31 male Work Crew inmates, 12 were on psychotropic medications. Of 13 male Work Release inmates, 3 were on psychotropic medications. Total medicated males at PRC equaled 23.08%.
- Of 11 female Work Crew inmates, 7 were on psychotropic medications. Of 4 females Work Release, 2 was on psychotropic medications. Total medicated females at PRC equaled 60.00%.
- Psychotropic Medication at LCP: Of 212 males overall, 76 (35.85%) were on psychotropic medications. Of 28 females overall, 16 (57.14%) were on psychotropic medications.
- Total Medicated Inmates within the Prison System: Overall, PRC averaged 40.68% medicated inmates. LCP averaged 38.33% medicated inmates. The total average percentage equaled 38.80% medicated inmates in the prison system.

#### 4.6 Informational Highlights

- On March 5, 2026, Warden Shoemaker provided a tour of the prison to a Community Corrections class from Lycoming College.
- On March 9, 2026, Prison and PRC Administration met with Cost Management Plus representative Julia Alday. The Prison Inmate Medical Cost Containment (PIMCC) Program report indicated our healthcare savings for the period of September 2025 through February 2026 totaled \$408,511.84 for outpatient services and \$169,813.52 for inpatient services.
- On March 9-13, 2026, Correctional Counselor Mikaela Brunozzi attended Basic Hostage Negotiations Training held in State College, PA.
- On March 10, 2026, Lt Josh Rogers attended Glock Armorer Training held in Wilkes Barre, Pa.
- On March 19-20, 2026, Sgt. Mark Stetts and RSII Lane Gibson attended Taser Instructor Certification in Coal Township, PA.
- On March 29 – April 1, 2026, Deputy Warden Ebner, Deputy Warden Barnes and Warden Shoemaker attended the PA County Corrections Association Spring 2026 Conference in Lancaster, PA.
