1.0 Regularly Scheduled Prison Board Meeting Called to Order by Commissioner Scott Metzger.

- 1.1 Meeting convened at 8:35 A.M.
- 1.2 Approval of Minutes: Mark Musina motioned for approval of May 2026 meeting minutes. Nicki Gottschall seconded the motion; the motion carried.
- 1.3 Public Comment (Agenda Items Only) – None

2.0 Expenditure Report:

- 2.1 Approval of Expenditure Report: Nicki Gottschall motioned for the approval of May 2026 Expenditure Report. Mark Mussina seconded the motion; the motion was carried.

3.0 Personnel Actions:

3.1 Mark Mussina made a motion to accept new hires; seconded by Nicki Gottschall, the motion was carried.

4.0 Informational Reports/Highlights: Warden Shoemaker reviewed the May Prison Reports as follows:

4.1 Population:

- Males in blocks averaged 208.29; males in PRC averaged 53.03; the total average daily population of males equaled 264.32, with a peak of 271.00.
- Females in blocks averaged 30.55; females in PRC averaged 19.77, the total average daily population of females equaled 50.32, with a peak of 56.00.
- The combined average daily population of male/female population equaled 314.65, with a peak of 307.80.
- In-Home detention averaged 0.00 males and 0.00 females.
- With no overcrowding transfer population, the total average daily population was equal to the monthly average daily population of 314.65.

4.2 Prison Disciplinary Hearings conducted and chaired by Deputy Warden of Inmate Services Barnes:

- Of 66 hearings conducted for 49 inmates, 11 inmates had more than one incident. 58 hearings resulted in guilty lock-ups; 7 hearing resulted in guilty lock-up with time suspended; 1 inmate was found not guilty; and, staff generated 15 informational reports.

4.3 Pre-Release

Work Release males equaled 12 and females equaled 3.

- Work crew males equaled 37 and work crew females equaled 12.
- The monthly average for males at the Pre-Release Center equaled 44 and females equaled 17. The year-to-date average equaled 47 males and 15 females.

4.4 Mental Health Snapshot taken on June 6, 2026:

- Of 328 total inmates in the prison system, 277 males and 51 females were categorized as follows.
- 99 males and 6 females made up Roster A, those who had no mental health history, which equated to 32.01% of the population.
- 48 males and 7 females made up Roster B, those who had past mental health history but no active symptoms in the last year, which equated to 16.77% of the population.
- 120 males and 32 females made up Roster C, those who had current mental health issues, which equated to 46.34% of the population.
- 10 males and 6 females made up Roster D, those who were determined to have serious mental illness, which equated to 4.88% of the population.

4.5 Psychotropic Medication at PRC:

- Of 47 male Work Crew inmates, 16 were on psychotropic medications. Of 14 male Work Release inmates, 3 were on psychotropic medications. Total medicated males at PRC equaled 31.15%.
- Of 14 female Work Crew inmates, 11 were on psychotropic medications. Of 3 females Work Release, 2 was on psychotropic medications. Total medicated females at PRC equaled 76.47%.
- Psychotropic Medication at LCP: Of 204 males overall, 83 (40.69%) were on psychotropic medications. Of 32 females overall, 23 (71.88%) were on psychotropic medications.
- Total Medicated Inmates within the Prison System: Overall, PRC averaged 41.02% medicated inmates. LCP averaged 44.92% medicated inmates. The total average percentage equaled 43.95% medicated inmates in the prison system.

- On May 13, 2026, Correctional Officer Michaela Allen and Resident Supervisor Bryant Solomon completed Basic Training at the Department of Corrections Training Academy in Elizabethtown, Pa..
- On May 13 and 29, 2026, Correctional Staff Attended Employee Training and Development conducted by Training Sgt. Billie Mitcheltree.
- On May 15, 2026, Correctional Staff attended Taser Training conducted by Training Sgt. Billie Micheltree.

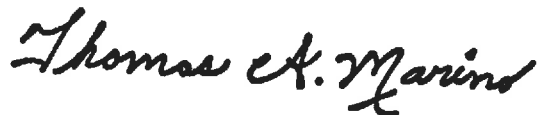
